Many things needed for construction work such as Gold, Silver, Copper, Gems, Pearls, Beads and clay appeared in different villages when King Dutugemunu was thinking about constructing a Stūpa in honour of Lord Buddha. Proof of these can be seen in these villages even now. The Chronicles elaborate these facts.

It is evident that no other Chethiya excels Ratnamali Maha Chethiya.
